Community Impact Snapshot

EDUCATION

10,350 books delivered through Dolly Parton's Imagination Library.

Pinebelt Foundation's AMPACT Reading Corps program provided literacy tutoring to 192 students.

75 infants, toddlers, and preschoolers with developmental disabilities received specialized interventions through The Children's Center for Communication and Development.

HEALTH

463 forensic interviews were conducted at Kid's Hub Child Advocacy Center with children who survived abuse.

The Fellowship Health Clinic provided clinical services to 137 people.

220 adults received services through Hope Community Collective's Project Hope, which includes drug and alcohol addiction recovery, anger management, and parenting education.

ECONOMIC MOBILITY

207 individuals received financial literacy coaching through the THRIVE program at Christian Services.

RISE served 129 individuals in their work-and-life-skills training.

SUPPORT SERVICES

14,700 individuals enrolled in feeding programs through Christian Services, Edwards Street Fellowship Center Food Pantry, and Hope Community Collective.
